

BEACONSFIELD FORMER TAFE SITE REDEVELOPMENT

Project Update - August 2023

Lots of exciting things are happening around our former Beaconsfield TAFE Site, and we have been busy getting plans in place to transform the site into a new residential community.

With opportunity for approximately 155 climate responsive homes incorporating water sensitive urban designs, the proposed redevelopment will feature community facilities with at least ten per cent of the site to be retained for public open space.

The precinct will provide a mix of housing types, including single residential lots, townhouses, grouped housing and apartments, offering a range of affordable and social housing options.



Local Structure Plan released for public comment

The project recently achieved a significant milestone when we lodged the Local Structure Plan (LSP) with the City of Fremantle. The LSP is based on the draft Concept Plan, released in March 2023, which was informed by our October 2022 public consultation and the City of Fremantle's The Heart of Beaconsfield Masterplan.

The LSP over the 3.8ha site has been released by the City of Fremantle for public comment until 6 October 2023, providing further opportunity for community input.

The public comment period is managed by the City of Fremantle and provides an opportunity to review our LSP, which sets out how the land is intended to be developed and provides a broad planning framework for the site.

What is a LSP?

A Local Structure Plan is like a roadmap for how a neighbourhood or area should be built.

It shows where buildings, parks, roads, and other things should go.

It helps decide what can be built there, estimated building quantities and how they should look.
